Governance, Risk & Compliance (GRC) is a management framework that integrates organisations and processes based on internal targets, company strategy, legal rules and regulations and the various stakeholder interests.

Together with the RUG, MBDadvice regularly organises these GRC conferences to discuss specific subjects of the GRC framework. The workshops discuss real practical cases which help participants to structure and balance their risk and business opportunities in order to obtain maximum benefits for their organisations.

The central theme of this workshop is:

Culture or Structure or Cultural Structures: What's in a name!

The workshop will open with a session on recent GRC developments, followed by a discussion how to motivate staff by management control. Control is often seen as a demotivator, but can we turn it around, providing the first opportunity to discuss the central theme of the workshop: is it culture, structure or a combination of the two?

The next day we have a session on incident analysis. The incident analysis tools Tripod and Hazop, have proven beneficial for improving safety and technical standards. Can we use these mature methods to become a truly learning organisation? Furthermore, a telecom company will give insight in the roll out of their GRC framework and one of the participating companies will provide feedback on how they benefitted from the advice from the participants in the previous workshop.

The diversity of the lecturers with an academic, business, semi public and/or consultancy background, ensures a broad perspective on the various elements of the GRC environment including latest developments and practical implications. The number of participants is limited to ensure maximum interaction with lecturers and between themselves.
